- Franklin Mill preplan is being re-worked and will be released by C1 when complete
- Courses available at the MA fire academy on LNG/LP fires. Contact C3 if interested.
- Firehouse reporting: Yantic is now online and a few reports have been entered. C3, C139, and FF Adelman-Hyde are working on getting the system ready for widespread use. At this point we are only entering the bare minimum due to system errors.
- City-wide SCBA bids: The total bid package is approx. 1.3million dollars. Being considered is a plan to have Yantic and the CCD wait for replacement and move forward with the remaining companies; then complete the purchase in a few years to have Yantic and the City on the new standard.
- City-wide radio: a bid package is being completed for city-wide restructuring of the radios. The plan is to move into the 700-800mHz bandwidth and is to include public works, utilities, and the PD. The entire process is scheduled for 5-7 years. Mutual aid operations are unknown right now. Additional information gathering will be completed.
- Following the City elections, the Chief has reached out to the newly elected officials in order to welcome them and initiate communications between the council and the fire department.
